Course Introduction

Managers and researchers have turned their attention to business ethics because of recent corporate scandals. Some sense of ethical behavior is needed as well. In this course, we will investigate some of the ethical issues facing businesses including acceptable risk, intellectual property, worker's rights, and ethical issues in marketing. Students will come to realize the various bases from traditional philosophical and theological sources for ethical practices.
