## Course Introduction

In the 2nd semester of conversation course we will emphasize more on practice of talking and expressing. Expressing oneself is more important than listening comprehension here. Since freshmen students have at least two hours learning listening comprehension in the language lab, students in conversation class will be encouraged and stimulated to talk as much as they can. "Show & Tell", for example, will be a very important in-class presentation in this semester.
