Course Introduction	This course is designed to accommodate the needs of freshmen majoring in various disciplines. Its main aim is to teach students the basic Chinese classical texts in English, with a focus on writing and speaking abilities. The training in this course will enable them to express their knowledge in Chinese classics using English whether in a written form or in a conversation. This type of knowledge is a prerequisite to presenting the Chinese culture in a broader sense and in various environments.
