Requirement	大學部日間部學生,須於畢業前完成「社團學習與實作」1學分,課程分為A「人門課程」、B「活動參與」、C「活動執行」三部分皆通過後,計入修課該學期實得學分「1學分」「通過」。修課規定: (一)日間部學生需修習本課程三部份完成後,記錄為「人門課程」修課學期實得1學分。 (二)「人門課程」其修課學分數列人當學期選課規定之學分數內;但該學分不列人二分之一不及格學分數計算,且其成績不列入學期平均成績計算。同時該學分數不列入該學期二分之一不及格學分數之計算基數。 (三)「活動參與」及「活動執行」,日間部學生於畢業前完成;進學班於入門課程隨班完成。人門課程上課規定: (一)本課程依各系班級分為單週或雙週上課,每次2小時,日間部共上6次課,進學班共上8次課,無故不到者以順課論,實際上課日期請詳教學計畫表。第1次上課,尚未完成選課手續者,應先暫時在預攤班級上課,並取得上課證明(課後請該任課教師簽名),否則該堂視為順課。 (二)學生因病或其他特殊事故不能上課時,須依照本校學生請假規則辦理。學生經核准請假而缺席者為缺課,未經請假或請假未准而缺席者為曠課。缺課及曠課之處理規定如下: 1、曠課1小時作缺課2小時論。 2、缺課總時數已達該科目全學期所授課程時數三分之一,依本校學則規定辦理。 [English version] 1. Class performance, learning sheets and planning accomplishments are adopted for grading standard. 2. Students who gain 1 credit in the semester which complete all the parts of this course.
