Course Introduction	<p>The language skills of Russian letters, phonetics, vocabulary, sentence patterns and grammar are taught step by step. Through sentence pattern exercises, situational dialogues, listening and speaking practice, reading and pronunciation, you will develop basic Russian (A1) listening, speaking, reading, master communicative language used in daily life, and learn about the Russian way of life and culture through language learning. At the same time, you will cultivate an active learning attitude through games and situational role-playing and generate enthusiasm for learning Russian.</p>
