Course Introduction	The objective of this one-year course is to teach basic German language skills at the level A1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. In class all four language skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening) will be trained. In class the textbook "DaF kompakt A1" will be used, however, additional materials from other textbooks as well as additional audio-visual materials will also be introduced when appropriate.
